

Subject: Overseas Export of Alcohol.

CIRCULAR

No.DNS.1195/45068/IV(1)

Mumbai 7th June 1996.

Under this Office Circular of even No. dated 18th May 1996, instructions have been issued that export of alcohol to overseas should be allowed only through Bombay or Nhava Sheva port and that the bond in form 'A' under Rule 5 of Maharashtra Foreign Liquor (Transport and Export under bond) Rules, 1968, shall be supported by 100% cash or bank guarantee equivalent to duty leviable on the quantity exported. In partial modification of these instructions it is clarified that cash or bank guarantee to cover bond amount may be taken 10% of the amount of duty involved, or surety equivalent to 100% duty involved given by the Chairman or Managing Director of the Distillery concerned in the form appended as a schedule to bond in form 'A'. Security so given can be revolving i.e. can be used again on receipt of consignment in Bombay or Nhava Sheva port from the Excise Officer posted there.

2% It has been also decided that parties desiring to export alcohol out of India through any port other than port of Maharashtra may be allowed to do so. However, the facility of revolving security should not be extended in such case. In such cases, the bond should be discharged only after intimation of having despatched goods out of India is received from the Custom Station Officer of the port concerned.
