Sub: Verification of genuineness
of import permit.

It has been reported by liquor companies that there is a huge delay taking place at the point of export on account of difficulties in verification of import permits with the importing State.

2. Due to this delay, many times the permit lapses and therefore the export do not materialise or have to be renewed.

3. In order to get over the above difficulties, the following revised procedure is prescribed.

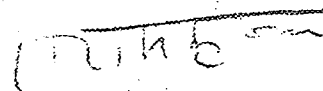
On receipt of import permit, the distillery officer may permit the export of the consignment if the party to whom it is to be exported is one of the regular party whose credentials have been verified earlier by the officers.

ii) The distillery officer may thereafter go for permit verification on random basis with the officers of the concerned importing States.

iii) In respect of parties who are importing for the first time from Maharashtra the distillery officer may first verify the genuineness of the import permit and only thereafter shall permit export.

4. In case where the volume of export is very large, the distillery officer must do random verification of the permits to the extent of 10 - 20% of the total permits issued and shall record accordingly in their register.

5. This circular shall come into effect with immediate effect.
